Parental/Child Consent for use of Technology and Data Storage:-

Internet Safety

We are keen to keep up to date with the latest technology in school as we believe that it will enhance your child's education. The internet provides an exciting opportunity for your child to access a wealth of resources which have not always been available on this scale. We are aware that there is the potential for children to access unsuitable materials but we have taken steps to deal with this. The school internet operates a filtering system which is designed to restrict access to inappropriate material. Internet access is monitored closely and any misuse is reported and is acted upon immediately.

We have devised the following set of rules which we ask the children to follow to ensure their safety.

Internet Safety Rules

1. Always use computers responsibly, handling them carefully and following the internet safety rules.
2. Always tell an adult when you are using the Internet.
3. Always be nice to people on the computer like you would in the playground.
4. Only share your username and password with your parents/carers.
5. Don't talk to anyone you don't know on the internet.
6. Don't open email messages or pop ups from strangers as they may contain nasty viruses that break your computer.
7. Always handle computers carefully and do not change their settings without adult permission.
8. Never type in your personal details on the internet unless your parents say yes.
9. Always talk to an adult if you are worried or unsure about anything on the internet.

We have identified the positive impact of using digital images and videos of the children at school, to promote learning and to publicly celebrate the children's successes in and out of school. Rules for using children's images and videos in and out of school

1. Photographs/videos of individual children will only be used to promote learning or to publicly celebrate successes when parental consent is given.
2. The name of a child will not be revealed next to an image or video of that child.
3. Children's images will only appear when the children are appropriately dressed.
4. Photographs will be stored securely and will be kept no longer than is necessary.
