RE: Parking on School Site

Dear Parents / Guardian

It has become apparent that many parents / guardians are using the school car park to pick up from after school clubs. On Mondays in particular, this is incredibly busy.

I am writing to remind parents / carers that access to the car park is granted to those with mobility problems / disabilities who have been allocated a car parking pass. If you have not been granted a parking pass, please refrain from entering the car park at any time.

Today, numerous cars were parked in our disabled bays and on double yellow lines on the roundabout. As well as being inconsiderate to genuine adults who need the disabled bays, this constitutes a significant risk to access for emergency services needing to access, not to mention the risk to pupils at this time.

Parents / Carers wishing to collect from after school club should park normally (e.g. in the Portland Bus Park or on Sparken Hill) if they are wishing to collect pupils at this time.

The vehicle gates to Sparken Hill will be closed following our security patrol end of shift – usually 3.45pm as a consequence. Any unauthorised parking on site will be reported to the authorities and parents may risk a ban from school site as a result.
