Key indicator 1: The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – Chief Medical Officers guidelines recommend that primary school pupils undertake at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day in school

- Pupils have access to a range of afterschool sport and physical activity clubs  
Autumn 1- **13** weekly sessions, **253** weekly attendances, **56%** girls, **39%** PP, **9%** SEN  
Autumn 2- **7** weekly sessions, **143** weekly attendances, **65%** girls, **33%** PP, **8%** SEN  
Spring 1- **7** weekly sessions, **145** weekly attendances, **71%** girls, **30%** PP, **8%** SEN  
Spring 2- **11** weekly sessions, **243** weekly attendances, **58%** girls, **26%** PP, **7%** SEN  
Summer 1 - **13** weekly sessions, **251** weekly attendances, **61%** girls, **33%** PP, **8%** SEN  
Summer 2 - **13** weekly sessions, **251** weekly attendances, **61%** girls, **33%** PP, **8%** SEN
- Pupils have access to physical activity at breakfast clubs  
An average of **50** pupils are active at breakfast club every morning.
- **18** Sports Crew & Ambassadors delivering daily lunchtime activities for their peers.
  - **45** Playworkers supporting the delivery of lunchtime activities for KS1
    - A range of activities delivered by midday staff

Key indicator 2: The profile of PESSPA being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement

- Curriculum based Orienteering used across school.
- 27 pupils attending Intervention Workshops/Sessions
  - School Games Platinum achieved June 2024
    - End of year dance show
- 58% of KS1 Year 1 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education
- 67% of KS1 Year 2 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education
- 67% of LKS2 Year 3 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education
- 69% of LKS2 Year 4 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education
- 70% of UKS2 Year 5 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education
- 73% of UKS2 Year 6 pupils achieved ARE in Physical Education

Key indicator 3: Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport

- Staff provided with CPD opportunities linked to Bassetlaw School Games Partnership.

Key indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

## Key indicator 5: Increased participation in competitive sport

- Pupils provided with opportunities to access a range of competitive opportunities, including events, festivals, leagues and friendly matches.

Autumn 1 - **11** events, **113** pupils, **25%** girls, **35%** PP, **7%** SEN

Autumn 2 - **6** events, **91** pupils, **41%** girls, **35%** PP, **5%** SEN

Spring 1 - **5** events, **73** pupils, **74%** girls, **36%** PP, **5%** SEN

Spring 2 - **15** events, **221** pupils, **55%** girls, **28%** PP, **10%** SEN

Summer 1 - **7** events, **239** pupils, **51%** girls, **49%** PP, **17%** SEN

Summer 2 - **11** events, **17** pupils, **34%** girls, **41%** PP, **9%** SEN

- Termly House Sport Competitions provided for pupils.

Autumn 1 – **2** sports – **313** pupils participating

Autumn 2 – **0** sport – **0** pupils participating
